Btec Advanced Award in Management of Gypsy & Traveller Sites

A qualification aimed at those attending the Managing Accommodation and Implementation of Government Requirements courses. Assessment is based on a portfolio of evidence gathered from attendance at the courses and from daily working activities.

Gypsies & Travellers: Cultural Awareness A one day event aimed at anyone wishing to increase their knowledge of the similarities and differences between the different cultures including Romany, Irish Travellers, Show People, Bargees, New Age Travellers and others. The course will also introduce introductory words and phrases in the Roma language.

Gypsies & Travellers: Working in Partnership with Social Welfare Agencies

A course for those with social welfare responsibility for the Gypsy and Traveller community focusing on the issues and implications involved in multi-agency working.
